TASTING NOTES:

OUR PLATEAU BLOCK IS A 3.8 ACRE CHUNK OF WINDROW VINEYARD PLANTED IN 1996. SITTING ON TOP OF THE BENCH ON LEVEL GROUND, THE SOIL PROFILE IS DEEP AND LUSH. TRAINED TO THE SCOTT HENDRY TRELLIS DESIGN, 4 CORDONS, TWO ABOVE TWO, THE AVERAGE YIELD HAS BEEN 2.9 TONS PER ACRE. FROM START TO FINISH FLORAL NOTES ARE ACCENTED BY BRIGHT MIRABELLE PLUM FLAVORS ALONGSIDE DUSTY BLACK PEPPER AND DRIED CURRANTS. THE STRUCTURE IS FIRM, YET NOT OVERBEARING. WE ARE PLEASED TO OFFER YOU THIS SINGLE-BLOCK WINE FROM OUR HISTORIC ESTATE. WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO ENJOY THIS BEAUTIFUL WINE WITH BRAISED SHORT RIBS OR VEAL CHOPS.
